## ...for the next ReGeneration 2030 Summit!

24–26 August 2019 on the Åland Islands

### Theme: Changing climate, changing lifestyles!

This year's Summit will build upon the outcomes of the Summit of 2018. By continuing to look for and implement solutions to reach SDG12: Responsible Consumption and Production Patterns, we will also include the connection to SDG13: Climate Action. The participants will get a chance to look at practical solutions for making the vision of the Manifesto become reality: "Make sustainable consumption and production the new norm in the Nordic and Baltic Sea regions" and for how to work with the commitments and demands on a practical level.

A more detailed Agenda will be presented during the spring of 2019.

#### About the ReGeneration 2030 Summits:

**What:** A meeting place where the youth discuss and propose solutions to reach the UN sustainable development goals (SDGs). While creating a platform and a movement for solutions and learning across generations, the participants have the opportunity to meet and discuss solutions with key stakeholders of society.

**Why:** In sustainable development, the discussions often centre around the future and the world that will be transferred to the youth. However, it is rare that the youth take the lead in discussions about the present and the future.

**Where:** The idea of the movement ReGeneration 2030 was initiated from the local sustainability work on the Åland Islands – a network called "Bärkraft". The Åland Islands therefore becomes a natural meeting point for the Summits.

**How:** The annual ReGeneration 2030 Summits create an arena where the youth in the Nordic and Baltic Sea Regions\* meet to exchange knowledge and experience, to reflect and to act together. The Summits provide tools and help to find focal points for cooperation.

**For whom:** The main participants are 15-29-year-olds in the Nordic and Baltic Sea regions. We invite participants from older generations, such as established leaders from civil society, enterprises, politics, academia and the public sector are to take part in an intergenerational dialogue by meeting and discussing with the youth participants, come up with and listen to the solutions and messages.



**Applications for participation in the Summit 2019 will be open in March.**

**By whom:** ReGeneration 2030 is organised and led by numerous organisations and partners in the Nordic and Baltic Sea Regions.

\*The regions include: Denmark, Estonia, the Faroe Islands, Finland, Germany, Greenland, Iceland, Latvia, Lithuania, Norway, Poland, Russia, Sweden and the Åland Islands.
